3. Administer disciplinary actions fairly and in accordance with school and district policy.
4. Treat all individuals equally.
5. Respect the rights of all individuals.
6. Keep parents informed of the academic progress and of their children.
7. Emphasize the basic academic skills and subject matter.

The Student Will:

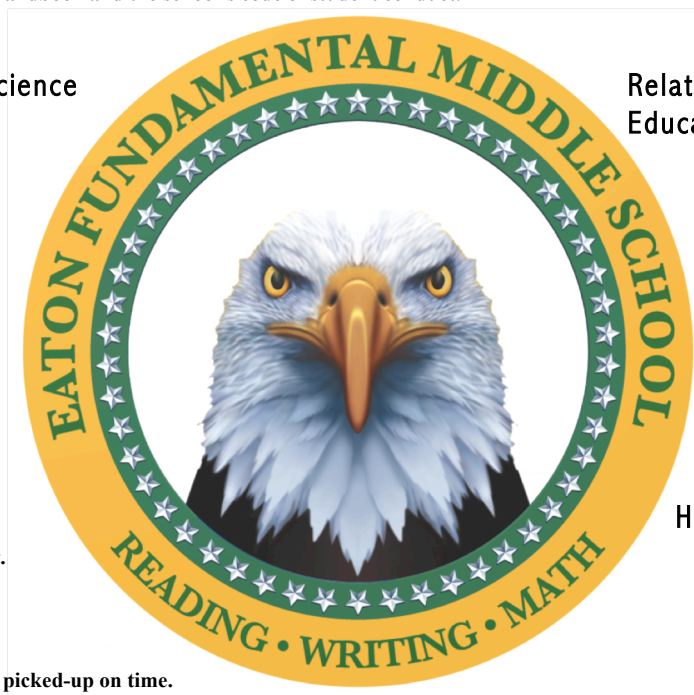
1. Demonstrate respect for authority, property, and the rights of others.
2. Follow the rules and regulations of the school.
3. Attend school regularly and comply with attendance regulations.
4. Comply with the school code of personal appearance.
5. Take the responsibility for fulfilling all assignments.
6. Have all necessary materials.
7. Comply with district and school disciplinary regulations.

The Parents/Guardian Will:

1. Support the rules and regulations of the school.
2. Foster respect for authority, property, and the rights of others.
3. Instruct their children to obey all attendance regulations.
4. Cooperate freely with the school in carrying out disciplinary action when necessary.
5. Works with the school in implementing recommendations, which the school feels, are in the child's best interest.
6. Encourage their children to comply with the school's dress code of personal appearance.
7. Attend conferences as requested concerning student progress and conduct.
8. Provide a study area at home.
9. Make certain that homework assignments are completed in a prompt and neat manner.
10. Make arrangements for each student to be transported to/from school. Each student will need to arrive and be picked-up on time.
